

PUBLIC NOTICE

In compliance with section 9.10 & 9.15 of the New Jersey Pesticide Control Code (N.J.A.C. Title 7, Chapter 30), the Hudson County Department of Public Resources Mosquito Control Unit, 595 County Avenue Secaucus, New Jersey, will be applying pesticides for the control of adult mosquitoes on an area-wide basis, as needed, throughout Hudson County during the period of May 15th, 2005 through November 30th, 2005.

The pesticides to be used will be those recommended for the control of adult mosquitoes by the New Jersey Agricultural Experiment Station (NJAES), Rutgers University, which are resmethrin and piperonyl butoxide (Scourge®), malathion (Fyfanon® or Atrapa®), and/or pyrethrin (Pyricide®). Products may be applied by truck or handheld equipment and/or by aircraft, using thermal fog, Low Volume and/or Ultra Low Volume techniques. All applications will be made according to product labeling and NJAES recommendations.

Upon request, the pesticide applicator or applicator's business shall provide a resident with notification at least 12 hours prior to the application, except for quarantine and disease vector control only, when conditions necessitate pesticide applications sooner than that time.
