**Public Invited to Kennedy Blvd/32nd Street Pedestrian Crossing
Design Discussion — Wednesday, April 25th in Union City**

Jersey City, NJ — The Hudson County Division of Engineering will host a public scoping session for the proposed John F. Kennedy Boulevard pedestrian crossing on April 25, 2007 at 7:00PM at the Union City Day Care Center, located at 510 35th Street in Union City.

The purpose of this meeting is to solicit feedback from the public on the design of the pedestrian crossing and to provide an update on the project. The County hopes to ensure that the new crossing conforms to both the aesthetic sensibility and historic character of the surrounding neighborhood.

The pedestrian crossing alternatives for the intersection of Kennedy Boulevard

and 32nd Street included a bridge, a tunnel or at-grade improvements. The pedestrian bridge was selected as the preferred alternative.

“I urge residents to attend this meeting to keep up with the exciting project and offer their ideas on how to make it a good fit for the surrounding neighborhood,” said County Executive Tom DeGise. “We are determined to make Kennedy Boulevard safer and this is an important step in that direction.”
