**ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM THE
NEW JERSEY STATE DEPARTMENT OF
LABOR AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
FOR
WORKFIRST NEW JERSEY ALLOTMENTS
AND
AWARDING FUNDS TO SOCIAL SERVICES PROVIDERS
THROUGH A FAIR AND OPEN COMPETITIVE PROCESS
FOR EDUCATIONAL SERVICES
JULY 1, 2016 TO JUNE 30, 2017
(\$5,546,865.00)**

WHEREAS, by way of a Notice of Obligation dated June 30, 2016 from the New Jersey State Department of Labor and Workforce Development, the County of Hudson Workforce Development Area was awarded Workfirst New Jersey funds in the amount of **FIVE MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FORTY SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY FIVE 00/100 DOLLARS (\$5,546,865.00)**; and

WHEREAS, this Notice of Obligation will provide funding for Workfirst New Jersey allotments for the period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 2016 the County through its Department of Family Services and the Jersey City Employment Training Program, jointly issued a Competitive Request for Proposals (RFP) for educational services through Workfirst New Jersey funding; and

WHEREAS, the contract awards are not subject to "Pay to Play" requirements as they emanated from a fair and open competitive process; and

WHEREAS, on the due date of May 27, 2016, twenty four (24) responses were received; and

WHEREAS, these proposals were scored, and results of the scoring memorialized in a memorandum by the Purchasing Agent, and pursuant to that memo, the following recommendations for funding allocations are being made for the period of July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017:

WHEREAS, it is advantageous for the County to accept these funds for the above described purpose and said funds will be allocated for contract awards to social services providers for educational services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Hudson that:

1. The aforesaid recitals are incorporated therein as though fully set forth at length.
2. The Board hereby authorizes the County Executive, Thomas A. DeGise or County Administrator, Abraham Antun or Deputy County Administrator, Laurie Cotter or their lawfully appointed designee, to execute any and all documents and take any and all actions necessary to complete and realize the intent and purpose of this resolution.
3. The Board hereby accepts the \$5,546,865.00 grant funds from the New Jersey State Department of Labor and Workforce Development Workfirst New Jersey funds, which funds will be allocated to social services providers for educational services.


