**ALLOCATING FUNDS FROM
N.J. DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT
TO SUPPORT WELFARE-TO-WORK ACTIVITIES.
JULY 1, 2012 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2013
(\$5,807,402.00)**

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development has issued an award letter to the County of Hudson, in the amount of **FIVE MILLION, EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVEN THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED AND TWO (\$5,807,402.00) DOLLARS** to fund the continuation of the WorkFirst New Jersey welfare reform program – Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), General Assistance (GA); and

WHEREAS, the County of Hudson is desirous of allocating funds to initiate contracts for various employment, basic education skills training, and job search/readiness services, and

WHEREAS these funds are being recommended as the result of a fair and open competitive process, and not subject to “Pay to Play” requirements; and

WHEREAS the Director of the Hudson County Department of Family Services will have the authority to adjust funding levels during the contract period for various services within approved overall agency allocations, based upon customer utilization of these services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to this Grant Agreement with the State of New Jersey, the County Department of Family Services has recommended the initiation of subcontracts with the following social service agencies consistent with the WorkFirst New Jersey Regulations in the stated amount for the period of July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013.


