Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved \$203,963 from the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services Grant to address Opioid Use Disorder

Jersey City-The Hudson County Board of Commissioners approved \$203,963 from the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Mental Health and Addiction Services Grant to address opioid use disorder.

The funds will be utilized to help Hudson County municipalities address the issues surrounding opioid use disorder and drug abuse in their communities. These funds will also be used to provide prevention, education, intervention and addiction treatment services to the residents of Hudson County.

Under the County Based Innovation Projects these funds will also address prevention, early intervention, treatment and recovery support for Opioid Use Disorder. The funds are allocated as follows: Prevention, education, outreach to doctors, dentists and general practitioners – Partners in Prevention \$33,765, Sober activities for youth: social/recreational activities for youth ages 10 and older – Partners in prevention- \$45,000, Recovery supports: support/outreach/education, Hudson County Department of Health

and Human Services “STARS” Mobile Outreach Vehicle - \$55,000, Hudson County Department of Health and Human Services Administration -\$10,000, \$60,000 is unallocated at this time.

The program will run from September 30, 2022 through September 29, 2024.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to provide funds that will be used towards the reduction of opioid use by connecting individuals with opioid use disorder to medication assisted treatment and supporting individuals on a path to recovery.

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
