**Hudson County Commissioners authorize acceptance of a \$1,357,137 Grant from the New Jersey Department of Health & Human Services Youth Services Commission**

---

***Hudson County-*** The Hudson County Board of Commissioners authorizes the acceptance of a \$1,357,137 grant from the New Jersey Department of Health & Human Services Youth Services Commission.

The 2023 Grant is administered through the County of Hudson, and it is awarded to providers that serve Hudson County Juveniles who are at risk and or involved with the family court system. It permits county government to support a broad range of activities pertaining to all sorts of issues.

The following organizations will receive funding for their programs: Guazabara Insights, Violence Prevention Program, \$40,000, Guazabara Insights, Community Based Mentoring Program, \$17,500, Guazabara Insights, community based mentoring, \$75,230, Hudson County Department of Corrections, Electronic Monitoring Program, \$150,000, State of New Jersey Judiciary, MDT, \$45,000, United Cerebral Palsy of Hudson County, Transportation, \$5,000, Carepoint Health Foundation/HUMC, Project Impact, \$180,000, Carepoint Health Foundation, Youth Comprehensive Treatment, \$90,000, YMCA of

Newark & Vicinity, ERC, \$261,804, Family Partners of Hudson County, Truancy, \$30,000, North Bergen Board of Education, Restorative Community Services, \$50,000, Haven Adolescent Community Respite Center, Stationhouse Adjustment Program, HC DHHS Youth Services Commission, \$77,573, Administration, \$110,000, totaling \$1,357,137.

The term of the grant will run from January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023.

Board Chairman Anthony Vainieri and the Hudson County Board of Commissioners are committed to providing the necessary resources to assist providers that serve juveniles that are at risk or involved within the family court system.
